# The Universal 'Complete' Standoff

#### Safety

- **WARNING!** Ensure local authority, Health and Safety and general workshop practice regulations are adhered to when using this ladder standoff.
- · WARNING! Take care when using/moving ladders near power lines risk of fatal electric shock.
- · Keep the equipment in good condition.
- · Replace or repair damaged parts. Use genuine parts only.
- **WARNING!** Use ladder on level, solid ground and either have an assistant stand on the bottom rung or otherwise anchor the base to prevent slipping.
- · Place ladder at an angle of 65°-70° (or foot of ladder 1 metre from wall for each 4 metres up) for stability.
- · Where possible, tie top of ladder to building to prevent slipping.
- · WARNING! Never overreach when using the ladder stand-off.
- Keep children and unauthorised persons away from the working area and do not allow children to climb the equipment.
- · DO NOT stand on the stand-off tray. It is only for tools, paint pots etc.
- · DO NOT use the stand-off for any purpose other than that for which it is intended for.
- · DO NOT use the equipment damaged or parts missing as this may cause failure and personal injury.
- · DO NOT use if you feel tired or ill or if you are under the influence of alcohol, drugs or intoxicating medication.
- · Store in a safe, dry, childproof area when not in use.

#### Before assembly ensure the pack contains:


- 1. X1 Mainframe
- 2. X2 Rung Hooks (2)
- 3. X5 Bolts with Nuts & x1 Washer
- 4. X1 Spring Hook (4)

### Assembly:

Bolt the unit together as seen in the picture below by connecting mainframe to the rung hooks (2) using 4 bolts (3). Bolt the spring hook (4) into the centre hole on the main frame using the remaining bolt, nut and washer.

## Fitting the Standoff:

The standoff should be fitted on the 2 top rungs of the ladder, ensure all four rung hooks engage with the ladder rungs. Then pull the spring hook down and connect with the rung to secure the standoff to the ladder (see 4 below). **WARNING!** Exercise caution when hooking spring round ladder rung as the spring is very strong. **DO NOT** stand on the stand-off tray. It is only for tools, paint pots etc.
